The 2010 Dominican female student-athlete of the year was awarded to two seniors, standout soccer player Eleanna Mendez and women's volleyball player and golfer Gabby Pecora. Mendez started in all 19 games for the Lady Penguins in 2009 scored six goals. Pecora led the team with 401 kills and started in all 30 matches in 2009. She also participated in all of the women's golf team's 2010 tournament appearances.
